## - Cleaning and Maintenance of Laminate Surface.

To ensure the long-lasting beauty of your laminate surface, it's important to clean it properly. Proper cleaning can prevent potential issues.

- Regularly clean the laminate surface with a soft cloth or microfiber to prevent dust and dirt buildup.
- Use a mild soapy solution or a non-aggressive cleaner designed for laminate surfaces.
- After applying the cleaner, wipe the surface immediately with a damp cloth, and then thoroughly dry it with a dry cloth to prevent moisture retention, which could cause swelling or material damage.
- Do not expose laminate to direct contact with hot objects. Always use coasters under hot items, as high temperatures can damage or deform the laminate.
- Be cautious when handling sharp or heavy objects to avoid scratching or denting the surface. Use protective mats.
- Keep laminate out of prolonged direct sunlight exposure, which may cause color fading or loss of surface shine.

## **Never Use on Laminate Surface:**

- Abrasive sponges/powders they leave scratches.
- Steel wool sponges and abrasive cleaning agents.
- Harsh chemicals (acids, acetone, or solvents).
- Do not use excessive water, especially on edges and seams, as the laminate can absorb water and begin to swell.
